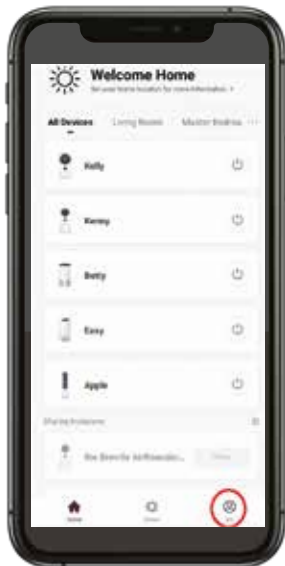
Before you can voice control your Breville device, you need to link your Breville Home Connect™ account to the Amazon Alexa or Google Home/Assistant app.

How to link Breville Home Connect™ to Amazon Alexa

- 1 Download the Amazon Alexa app.



- 2 Sign into both Amazon Alexa and Breville Home Connect™ apps.
- 3 In the Breville Home Connect™ app, tap on the “Me” tab on the bottom right.



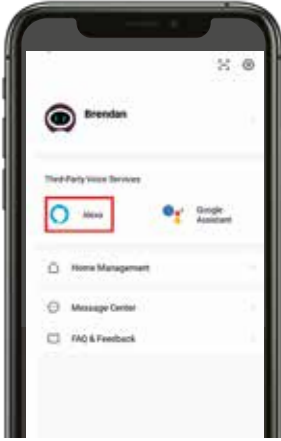

4 Tap on Alexa.



6 Tap "Link" on the next screen and if prompted, open with Breville Home Connect™.



5 On the next screen, tap on "Sign In With Amazon".



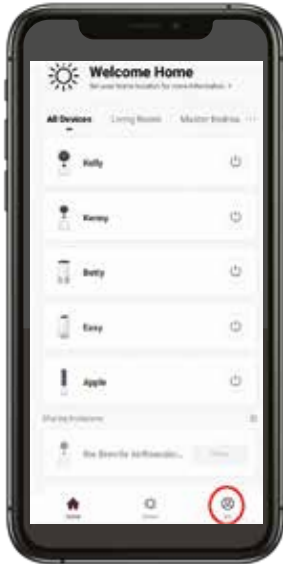

How to link Breville Home Connect™ to Google Home/Assistant

- 1 Download the Google Home/Assistant app.



- 2 Sign into both Google Home/Assistant and Breville Home Connect™ apps.
- 3 In the Breville Home Connect™ app, tap on the “Me” tab on the bottom right.



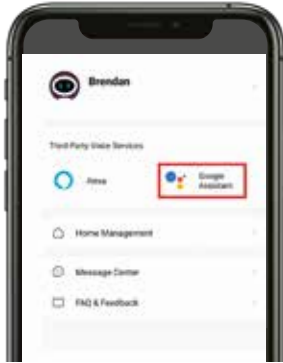

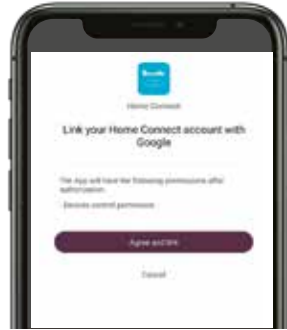

4 Tap on Google Assistant.



6 Tap on “Agree and link” to begin linking.



5 On the next screen, tap on “Link With Google Assistant”.



7 Once linking is complete, a list of voice assistant compatible devices will be shown. Simply tap the “X” to close this list or you can add each device into different rooms.
